- I. Review and Approve Notes from November 2021 meeting
- II. Review of Online Safety and ELL Parent Night
 - a. Mrs. Alvarez reported that the school had the assembly with NetSmartz and it went well. Additionally, they had the first ELL parent night in March which was a great start.
- III. Prior Year's Report and Implementation
 - a. Mrs. Alvarez reported the progress on last year's goals. Provost did not meet their goals, however, they did make progress. There were questions about whether the data shows an increase in student achievement in 6th grade since the addition of another teacher. Mrs. Alvarez reported that it was difficult to determine since the first year the teacher was hired was the COVID year. This is the first "normal" year we've had since the addition of another teacher.
- IV. Academic Needs for 2022-2023 School Year (Discussion)
 - Mrs. Alvarez proposed to continue funding the 6th grade teacher for next year and explained the need of utilizing more effectively professional learning communities (PLCs) to increase student learning.
- V. Plan for 2022-2023 Funds (discussion, vote)
 - a. The plan for the 2022-2023 funds (continuing to fund an additional 6th grade teacher) was discussed and voted on. All voted in favor with two members absent.
