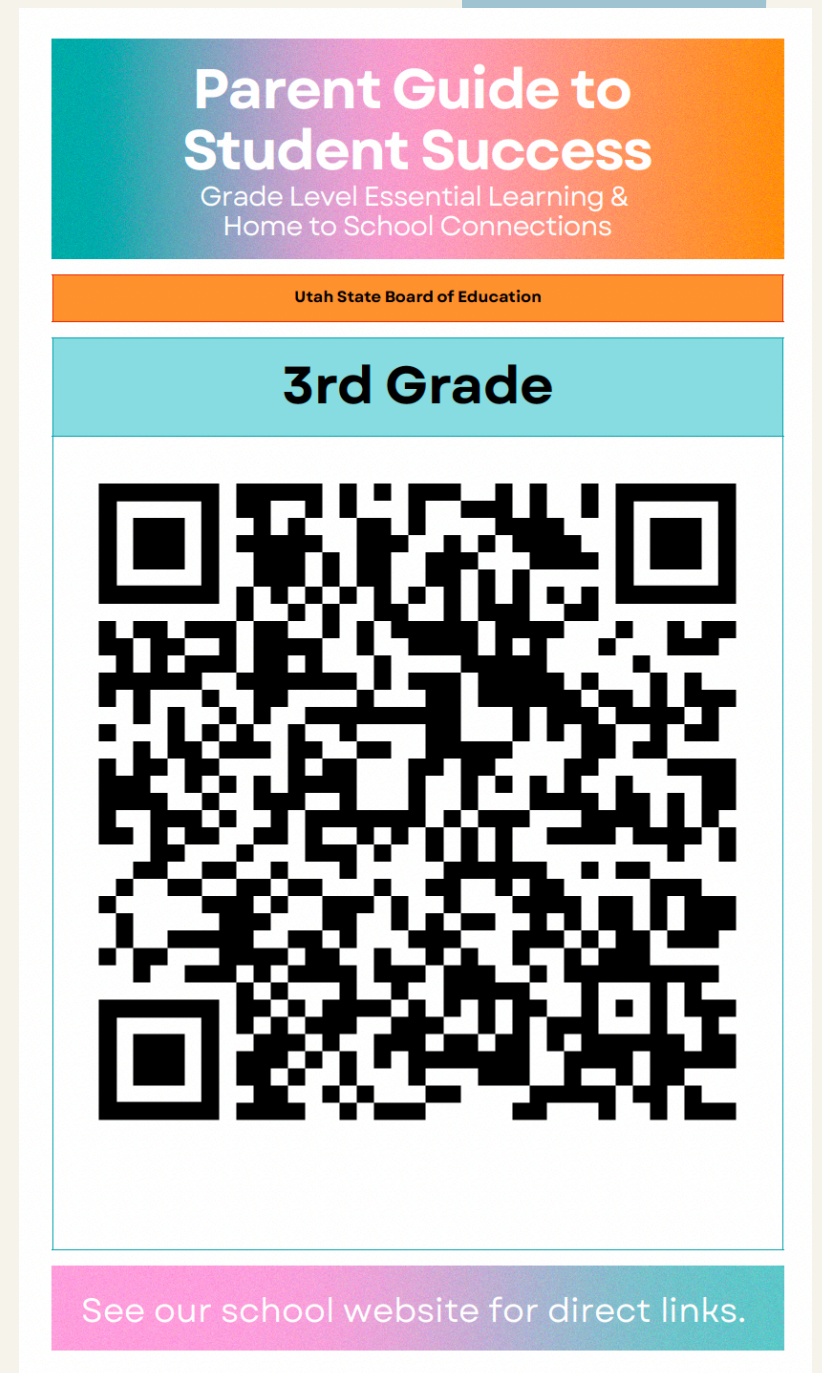

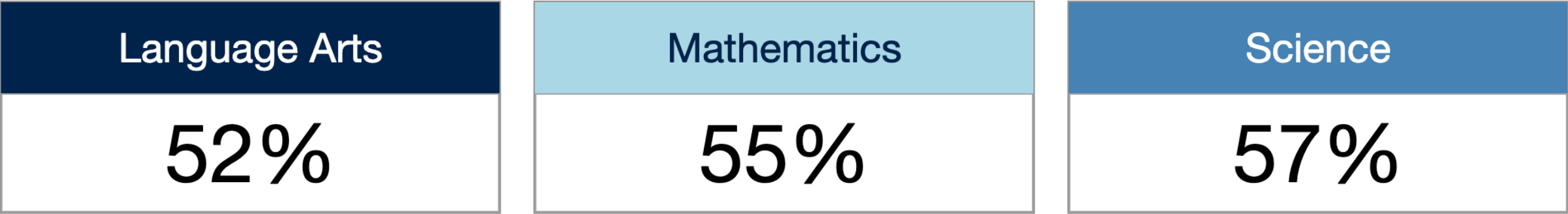
Curriculum & Instruction

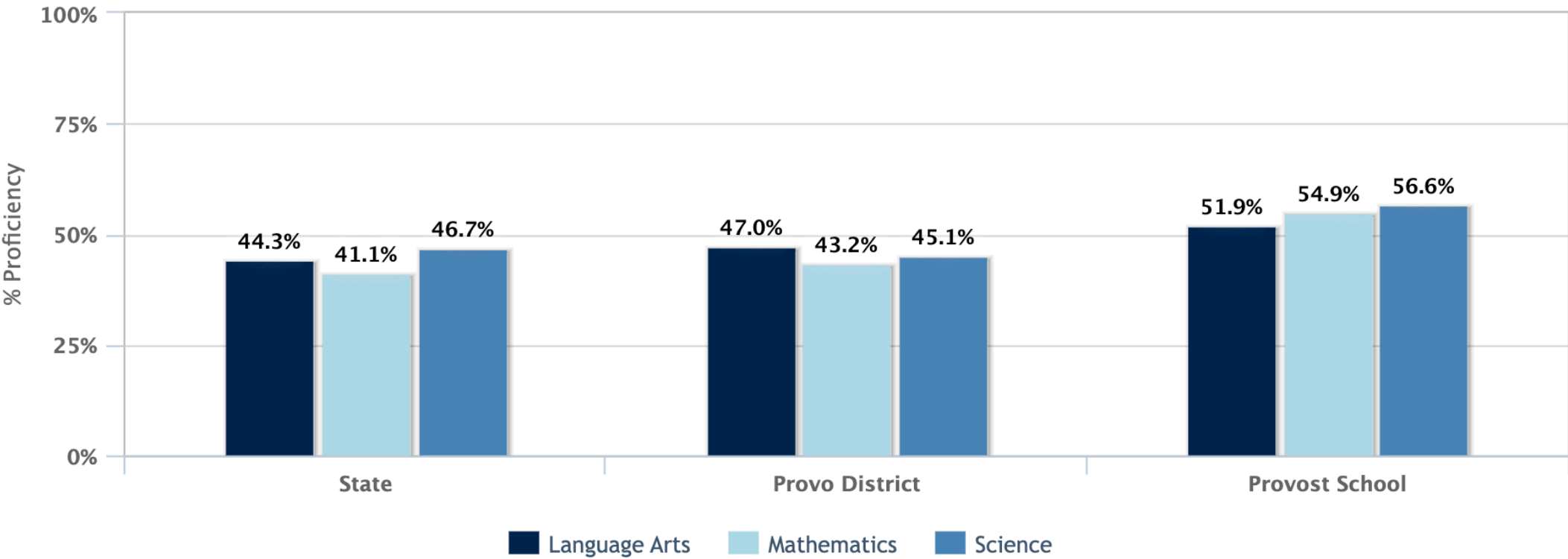
- In-class sheltered instruction

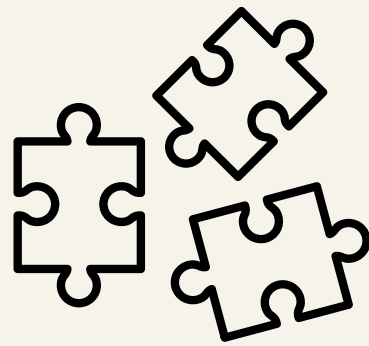

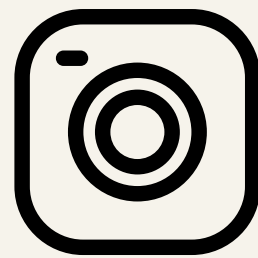
